Car: From the Gardiner Expressway, take Spadina Ave. north to College St. Make a right turn onto College St. (east), and continue past Huron Street to St. George Street. Make a left on St. George Street (north) and continue to Galbraith Street; the Galbraith Building is located on the right. Parking: Available on Russel St., King's College Circle, or the underground parking lot on Huron Street just north of College St.
