Job Profile

The City of Cambridge has an immediate opening for a Waste Water operator. This position is responsible for the testing, monitoring, operations and the preventative maintenance of the City of Cambridge's Wastewater and Storm water collection systems.

What you will be doing

This position is responsible for performing maintenance operations in all areas of wastewater; operating various pieces of equipment; including combination vactor trucks, mainline and lateral cameras, rods, etc.; and, working in manholes/sewers and pump station environments.

- Inspects and maintains City wastewater collection facilities in accordance with required standards.
- Deals with malfunctions and repairs/replacement of pumps, valves air releases and other controls and equipment.
- Responds to service calls and customer complaints and various work programs within the Wastewater department following Standard Operating procedures.
- Valve and flow diversion, valve operation and maintenance
- Performs Collection system jetting and flushing,
- CCTV inspections of Sanitary system
- Perform daily tasks in sanitary pump stations following the City's Standard Operating Procedures ensuring proper documentation is recorded.
- Assists with the installation of new wastewater works.
- Provides direction to operator-in-training assigned to their wastewater system when required.
- Performs other duties as assigned.
- Must participate in the emergency call-out system, nights, weekend and holidays.

Education

High school Grade 12 diploma or equivalent

Minimum Requirements

- Valid DZ License
- Class 1 License for Wastewater Collection, as issued by the Ministry of the Environment and Climate Change (MOECC). Operator-In-Training (OIT) license may be considered.
- One to two years' experience in a municipal wastewater collection system, or similar operation.

- Ability to operate various pieces of equipment
- Ability to operate small maintenance tools and hand tools
- Ability to work with different computer software
- Post secondary education considered an asset.

- Confirmation that you are physically able to perform the essential duties of the position, as assessed through our third-party provider, prior to commencement in the position.
- Current and valid Police Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check to be provided prior to commencement in this position.
